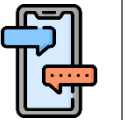

Machines or inventions people use to make life easier.

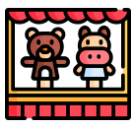
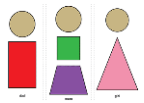
timeline
