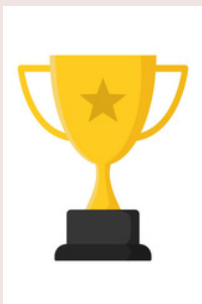
I have also been blown away by the improvements in the fluency of times tables recall in Year 4, the children really are ready for their multiplication check - great work!

A focus on School Uniform

At Stanhope, we are proud of our uniform. We wear a plain red jumper, sweatshirt or cardigan, a plain white or red polo shirt, black trousers, skirt or pinafore dress. In the summer, children can wear tailored school shorts or a red and white summer dress. Shoes should be black and have no heel.

Our PE kit is a plain black or red jumper or sweatshirt, white T shirt and black shorts or jogging bottoms. Children will need a pair of trainers for PE.

To help to ensure that the children are able to keep track of their own clothes, FOSS have secured a "freebie" of some personalised name labels for every child and these samples will be sent home soon to enable you to order any extras for the new term should you wish.
