What a busy week!

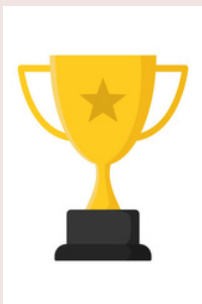

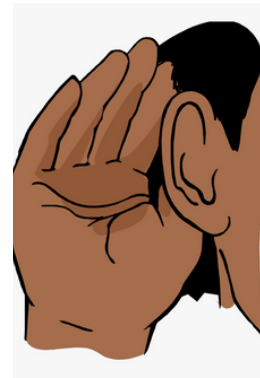
